"BUYER BEWARE"

- **"Caveat Emptor"** -- Common law doctrine that places the burden on buyers to reasonably examine property before making a purchase. A buyer who fails to meet this burden is unable to recover for defects in the product that would have been discovered had the burden been met. The phrase "caveat emptor" is Latin or "let the buyer beware."

NCAA DI FBS FOOTBALL REGULATORY BACKGROUND

- One-time Transfer Legislation
- Transfer Portal Windows
- Waiver of Counter Limit
- New Waiver Standards

OVERALL FBS FOOTBALL TRANSFER PORTAL KEY STATS

- Currently, 13% increase in transfers from 21-22
- 17% of FBS football athletes transferred in 21-22 cycle (overall among all FBS football scholarship athletes)
- 35% of FBS football athletes who entered the Portal this cycle (22/23) are graduate transfers

FBS FOOTBALL TRANSFER PORTAL 22/23 CYCLE TRENDS

- **Overall:** 44% of FBS football athletes "move down" to play at a lower level
- **Among G5 in the Portal:** 35% are "moving up" to P5. Only the top 20% of G5 athletes who enter the Portal make it to P5; close to 40% move down to FCS or lower
- **Among P5 in the Portal:** Almost 50% "move down" to play at a lower level/only 42% of P5 athletes have committed to another P5 school

FBS FOOTBALL TRANSFER PORTAL 22/23 PLAYERS REMAINING

- **Overall:** 28% (424 players) are still uncommitted/in the Portal
- 20% of **P5** players in the Portal remain uncommitted
- Close to 40 percent of **G5** players in the Portal remain uncommitted
- More than 60 percent of the players left in the Portal are **G5**
