## Major Pieces of Legislation as sources of funding

- Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (Bipartisan Infrastructure Law)
- Inflation Reduction Act
- Earmarks and Programmatic Funding through the Annual Appropriations Act

## Potential Upgrades

- Revitalization of underserved areas through facility upgrades.
- Upgrades to water and sewer systems.
- Improvement of roadways, parking lots, public transit options.
- Clean energy projects: solar, EV charging infrastructure, energy efficient systems, reduction of air pollution.
